An MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) is a method of looking inside the body. Instead of x-rays, the MRI scanner uses magnetism and radio waves to produce remarkably clear pictures. The magnet 'bore' is cylindrical in shape and is 4 feet long and has an internal diameter of 25 inches. This design allows more elbowroom and generous headroom of approximately 12 inches above your nose. The table lowers to 18 inches and can accommodate patients up to 550 pounds.

No special preparation is needed prior to the exam. At the time of your appointment you will be asked to complete several forms that detail your billing information, medical history, financial responsibility, safety screening, privacy notice and medical information release. Your appointment is scheduled to include time to complete these forms and counsel with the Technician.

If you have concerns that you may feel claustrophobic, please ask your referring physician for a sedative to take prior to your appointment and arrange transportation to/from your appointment. Physician prescribed sedatives can be taken after your arrival, but you will require transportation home.

Please bring your insurance card, and any authorizations or referrals that have been completed for this appointment. In addition, please also bring any prior MRIs, CT scans, and ultrasounds, x-rays or bone scans which may relate to this MRI scan.

If your clothing contains any metallic parts (including undergarments), you may be asked to remove your clothing in a private changing area and a gown/shorts will be provided for you. You will also be required to remove all of the following:
Jewelry • Watches • Hairpins • Glasses • Wallets • Cell phones • Pagers
Removable dental work will need to be taken out for scans of the head or neck

PLEASE NOTE: NO pacemakers are allowed inside the MRI room.

Your placement on the table will depend on the area to be scanned. IV contrast may be injected into your vein or joint, by the MRI Technician, to better define the area to be scanned. Throughout your scan, you will be in contact with the technician and have the ability to listen to music (you are welcomed to bring your own). For clear pictures, you will be asked to hold very still and relax, and at times to hold your breath. There is some noise associated with the scan, and earplugs are available for your comfort. The length of the exam varies on the area scanned, but lasts approximately 30 to 60 minutes.

After the scan, a Radiologist will review the pictures produced and a report will be sent to your referring physician(s) for follow-up.

If you need a copy of your films, please call 24 hours in advance so the staff will have time to prepare your records.
